STANDARDS FOR PRESENTATION OF ARTICLES

(Attached to Announcement 1 No. 1646 /TB-DHSPNTTW dated 26 / 7 /2024 of the National University of Arts Education)

Authors registering to submit papers to participate in the Conference need to complete a full paper report with a length of 8-12 A4 pages, Times New Roman (Vietnamese) and English font, font size 12, Multiple 1.3 line spacing. Left margin 2.5 cm, right margin 2.5 cm; 2.5 cm above and below.

The structure of the essay includes: Article title, author's full name, academic title, academic degree (only unit name, email address, mobile phone number are set in footnote mode, printed straight, font size 11); Article summary no more than 500 words, italicized, font size 11, keywords (3 - 5 words); The article content includes the following sections: Introduction, Research methods and data, Analytical contents, Conclusion, References, Appendix (if any). The specific presentation format is as follows:

NAME OF THE ARTICLE IN CAPITAL, BOLD LETTERS. LETTER SIZE 14, CENTER ALIGNED

Academic title, degree, full name (straight, bold, right margin, font size 12)
Work unit (faculty/department or equivalent, school/institute), straight, not bold,
font size 12 (set in footnote mode)

Email address and/or contact phone number straight, not bold, font size 12 (set in footnote mode)

Summary (italic, bold): italicized, not bold, font size 11

Keywords: 3 - 5 words/phrases (italic, not bold) font size 11

The content of the report is presented in the following format:

1. INTRODUCTION/ OPENNING (BOLD, CAPITAL LETTERS, FONT SIZE 12)

State the problem clearly/ the urgency/necessity, cause, and significance of the research problem

- 2. RESEARCH CONTENT
- 2.1. Research question/problem (Lowercase, bold, font size 12)
- 2.2. Research methods
- 2.2.1. (italic, font size 12)
- 2.2.2. (italic, font size 12)
- 2.3. Research result

3. CONCLUSION

REFERENCES

Include only references that are cited, used, and referred to for discussion in the article. Foreign references must be kept in their original text, not transcribed or translated.

References are arranged alphabetically, in the following order: author's last name/name (year of publication). Publication name. Volume, number, Place of production: publisher. The references are presented and cited according to Harvard Referencing.

For example: If a Vietnamese author publishes references in a foreign language, the citation must be presented according to the name on the document. For example: author Nguyen Van A publishes an article in English, with the name Nguyen, V.A. then in the article quoted by Nguyen, V.A. (2009).

References are books: Author's name (year of publication), Book title, Publisher, Place of publication.

For example: Nguyen Van A (2011), Aesthetic education for Middle School students, ABC Publishing House, Hanoi.

References are articles published in scientific journals (journal articles): Author's name (year of publication), 'Article title', Journal name, Number (Volume), Number of pages.

For example: Nguyen Van A (2011), 'Building a cultural environment in press agencies', X Magazine, 112 (2), 7-15.

Anderson, J. E. (1985), 'The Relative Inefficiency of Quota, The Cheese Case', American Economic Review, 75 (1), 178-90.
